

Background

This devotional can be used to help you grow as Christians together. Just follow the steps.

1. Parent(s): Read this ahead of time to prepare

We are made in the image of a Creator God (Genesis 1:27), so let's create!

This devotional is about visually depicting something that is based on Scripture. It will help us express our feelings during the Covid-19 pandemic, and encourages others during worship.

The end product will be used as a part of a video slide show in our online worship service!

SPECIAL NOTE: This is for people of all ages, no matter where or who you are!

2. Materials Needed

- a. A Bible
- b. Whatever materials you need to visually depict something. For some this might be pencils and crayons and paper, or it might be Lego, or a camera, or... (See step c below.)
- c. Smart phone (or scanner) and internet connection

3. Activity

- a. The Covid-19 pandemic has changed how we are living our day-to-day lives. Ask: What are some things that have perhaps changed in a good way, and what are some things that have perhaps changed in a bad way?
- b. Because of everything that is happening, we probably have a lot of feelings or emotions about what we're going through. Some might be happy, some might be sad. We might be afraid, or we might feel at peace. Brainstorm and look up Bible verses that either (a) help you feel better, or (b) that describe how you feel.
- c. (Remember, this is for people of all ages!) Create something visual based on your special verse. Some will want to draw a picture, or paint something. Some will create a scene out of playdough or Lego. Some will capture a picture with a camera. Other ideas are welcome too!
- d. Take a picture of (or scan) what you've created and:
 - -email it to Pastor Ruttan at matthew@westminsterpc.ca
 - -include your name and what verse it is based on
 - -do this by the due date: Noon on Thursday, April 23!
- e. The creations (along with your name and Bible verse) will be included in a video during worship on April 26th!
- f. Display your creation somewhere in your house or apartment.
